



## THE LORD DELIVERS

SCRIPTURAL REFERENCE  
Psalm 34:17-22

ADDITIONAL STUDY

### PRAYER

Declare your deliverance from the harassment of the enemy today, in whatever area you may have been afflicted, declare it is time to come out of it victoriously.

*Many are the afflictions of the righteous, But the LORD delivers him out of them all. – Psalms 34:19*

Life comes with its ups and downs and its twists and turns, but there's a God who in all things, work after the purpose of His will and works all things together for our good. Many are the BUTS (weakness, question mark, misnomer in an otherwise good life, etc.), of the righteous, BUT the Lord delivers them out of them all. David who wrote this didn't write theory; he wrote from personal experience. At the point he wrote this psalm, Saul was after his life and he had to feign madness before an enemy king.

David's life was always in danger even though he was a righteous man; he had many afflictions, but in all of them, he also experienced the deliverances of God. In the same way, you might be going through your share of afflictions; let that not question God's commitment to your eventual victory. Remember, "Faith does not necessarily immune us from troubles; it works our victory out."

Thank God for the 'But' in the second part of our text, it takes the sting out of the first part. 'BUT' is often used to raise an objection to something said earlier and present another truth or position. 'BUT' here suggests that things are about to change and that things won't always remain the same.

Even where it looks like there is no hope humanly speaking, God will deliver you and bring you out of that affliction because He saves from all kind of troubles.
