SOLVING PROBLEMS

A leader's primary job is to provide solutions to the many leadership challenges that arise in the course of dispensing his tasks. It is a function of thinking. Your ability to solve problems as a leader communicates a sense of confidence to your followers or team mates. Some innovative ways to solve problems:

- Seek to understand the problem, appraise the situation properly.
- Gather enough facts, ask questions and question the status quo.
- Explore different options to solving the problem. One solution doesn't fit all problems.
- Approach it with a positive mindset; understand that every problem has a solution.
- Use past experiences of success to solve problems of the same nature.
- Monitor and document the outcome of the solutions you proffered, this information will equip you in solving future problems.
- Get the Holy Spirit involved, it takes God's wisdom to solve a problem. As a Christian leader, you need God's counsel to solve daily problems.
