### CONFESSION

I AM WHO GOD SAYS I AM, not who my condition says I am; not who my feelings, pocket or academic qualification say I am. I HAVE A WARRANT (A DIVINE AUTHORIZATION) TO WIN over the circumstances in my life and to succeed exceedingly, in Jesus' name.

*And the Lord will make you the head and not the tail; you shall be above only, and not be beneath... - Deuteronomy 28:13*

We often read, in God's word, about the heroic deeds of men like us who went from victory to victory and shook their generations by mighty acts; but all these sometimes seem exaggerated to us. However, scriptures show us that God is willing to do 'greater works' than these through us and that we are fashioned to be victors.
