## SCRIPTURAL REFERENCE

Habakkuk 2:1-4

## ADDITIONAL STUDY

Exodus 4:14-17 &amp; 7:1, Judges 7:1-7 and Proverbs 14:28.

## PRAYER POINTS

1. God, help me to be the answer to someone's need for a purpose partner.
2. I call forth those who are to partner with me to achieve God's purpose for my life.

Then the Lord answered me and said: "Write the vision and make *it* plain on tablets, that he may run who reads it." ~ **Habakkuk 2:2**

Wherever you go to today, everyone talks about the power of vision and the need to have a vision for one's life. In fact, many get puzzled over their inability to find a worthwhile vision for their lives, and also for their organizations. Though good and powerful, a vision is not all there is to living a fulfilling life.
