I listened to an interview with **Rushion MacDonald.** His story reinforced the belief I have that no matter where you are in life, you can still reinvent yourself. To reinvent is to change something that already exists so that it appears entirely new or different. It is to improve upon something that already exists. The word is synonymous with 'remake, revamp, renovate, and refresh.' Thus, to reinvent yourself means, to make noticeable changes in your life that would produce a better or an improved version of 'YOU.' The Message translation of Proverbs 4:18 reveal that, "The ways of rightliving people glow with light; the longer they live, the brighter they shine." This is God's desire for every believer, that the longer we live, the better we should become. You can still pursue a career, learn something new, start an initiative, etc. So, as we have entered a new year, we should be thinking of making changes in our lives that will improve and make us better.
