PRAYER

Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit. – Proverbs 18:21

The tongue is the most powerful weapon God gave mankind. In it lies the power of life and death, i.e. the tongue can open doors of peace, joy & prosperity; and if misused, it can open the door of misfortune and losses. God created the world with His spoken words and He made us in His likeness, so we can also use words to frame our world.

Words are containers of power. Until you release power through words, you will remain a victim in the arena of life and success. Moreover, I had enough left over to put into savings. That is how powerful our words can be when we release them. Literally speaking, I got married and paid for all I wanted in 2001 with my mouth!
